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## After the interview

- If your interview has been organised by Asset Recruitment Ltd, call the Consultant who referred you to the position after the interview. She will want to talk to you prior to the interviewer calling to give feedback.
- If you are interested in progressing further, it will assist if your feelings about the position are known, combined with your perception of what the client’s reaction is likely to be.
- Discuss with your Consultant any ‘potential’ or ‘misperceived’ impressions that may have resulted during the interview. Sometimes nervousness hinders our ability to articulate ourselves as well as we may have liked during the interview.
- If you have been given a business card by the interviewer, follow up with a brief email thanking them for their time.
- Be patient, the recruitment process takes time. Have realistic expectations around timeframes in which you would expect to hear from the interviewer.
